



PUBLIC NOTICE

The voters of the Town of Kearny in 2018 adopted an alternative expenditure limitation - home rule option. The purpose of this election is for the continued use of the alternative expenditure limitation.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-563.01, the Town Council of Kearny voted to approve the proposed alternative expenditure limitation home rule option at its special meeting on 29 June 2022. The vote for approval was four (4) For and zero (0) Against with three (3) absent, no votes.

At the general election to be held on 8 November 2022 the voters of the Town of Kearny will vote on the question of an alternative expenditure limitation - home rule option.

With voter approval, the town shall be limited to the expenditure of estimated available revenues whether such expenditures are less than or exceed the State imposed limit. As an example, in 2023-2024, the state imposed limitation plus applicable constitutional exclusions will allow expenditures of \$8,364,086. Under the proposed alternative expenditure limitation, we estimate expenditures of \$9,066,631.

If the voters approve, the additional expenditure authority will be used for all local budgetary purposes including general government, public safety, public works, utilities, cultural and recreation, and capital improvements. Revenues received from federal, state and local sources will be used to fund such expenditures. The city/town property tax shall be limited to the amount prescribed in the Arizona State Constitution.
